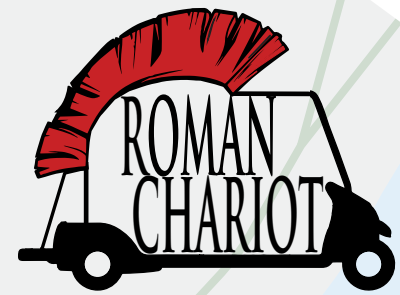
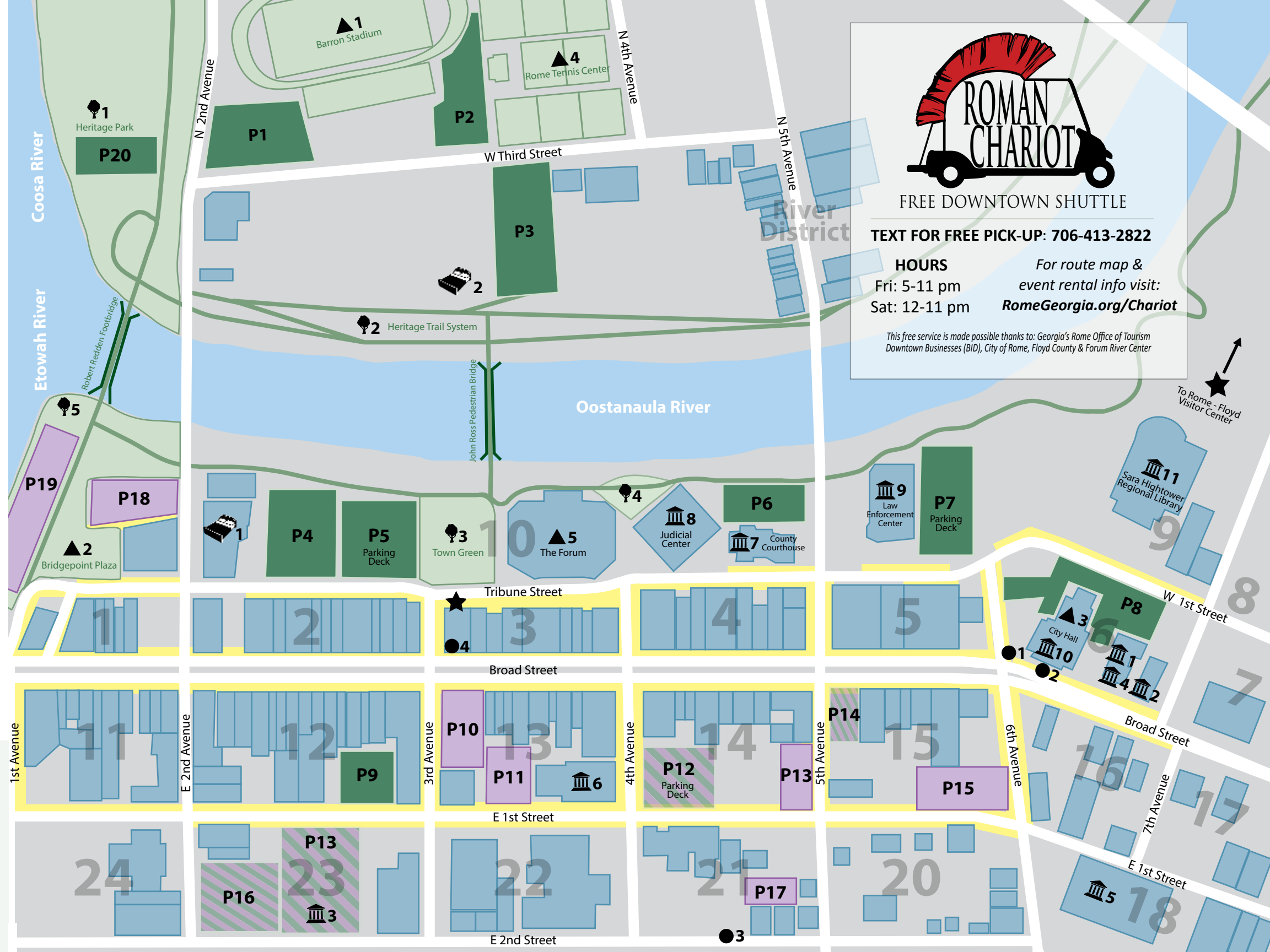
On-street parking indicated in yellow is limited to 2 hours
